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Introduction

Welcome to the 1.00.4051 release of MYOB Advanced Business.

What's New in this Release?

The 1.00.4051 release contains updates and fixes to the MYOB Advanced system. The following sections provide details of the features included in this release.

New Features

The new features introduced in this release of the MYOB Advanced Business are detailed below.

Default Payment Methods

All payment methods specific to AU or NZ are set to inactive by default, i.e. the **Active** check box is unticked for these methods on the Payment Methods form (CA.20.40.00). This prevents selection lists for payment methods from becoming unnecessarily long. Payment methods can be activated individually according to the needs of each company.

Online Storage of Multi-Company Sites

MYOB Advanced now supports online storage for sites with multiple companies. When setting up a multi-company site, MYOB Advanced ensures that information for all companies is stored in the same online location.

Admin Accounts Hidden

User accounts with the licence type MYOB_Partner and the Admin account used exclusively by MYOB are now hidden from all other users; they do not appear on user selection lists.

Note: These user accounts will still appear in selection lists on the Role List (SM.65.10.00) and Event > Attendees (CR.30.60.30) forms.

Resolved Issues

The following table details the issues that are addressed by this release.

Type	Description
Bug	Snapshots could not be imported if the site was deployed using a MySQL database. This has been resolved.
Bug	Preparing a snapshot for export failed with the error message "Specified cast is not valid." This has been resolved.
Bug	The GST and GST Tax Adjustment reports were grouped by Branch, which meant that in multi-branch situations the reports repeated for each company. This has been resolved.
