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Introduction

Welcome to the 2015.2.6 release of MYOB Advanced Business.

What's New in this Release?

The 2015.2.6 release features enhancements and fixes to issues identified in previous releases, in particular issues around product licensing. The following sections provide details of the changes included in this release.

Installing this Release

The 2015.2.6 service pack is automatically deployed to all production accounts.

An updated licence is required if you are upgrading from a version of MYOB Advanced prior to 2015.2. While accounts in our managed environment will have their licences updated automatically, a local installation must be updated manually by navigating to the Licence Maintenance (SM.20.15.10) form and clicking the **Update Licence** button.
