Resigning as the registered agent for a company (361)

If you're no longer acting as the registered ASIC agent for a client, you might want to remove them from your list of managed companies by lodging a 361- Notification of a registered agent to cease acting for a company form.

When you stop acting on behalf of the company:

- you won't receive any ASIC correspondence (including Annual statements) for the company.
- you won't be able to lodge forms on the company's behalf
- they'll no longer appear in your registered agent (RA) reports
- they'll no longer appear in your **Debts** view.

However, the company will continue to be an active client in MYOB Practice.

To resign as the registered agent for a company

- 1. Select your client from My List and click Corporate admin on the top menu bar.
- 2. Click Company forms.
- 3. In the Resign as agent row, click Prepare form. The Registered agent ceasing to act for a company page appears.
- 4. Click the drop-down and choose the registered agent for this company.
- 5. Enter the date that you want to cease acting as a registered agent. This date can't be a future date.
- 6. Type the name of the company that you'll cease acting for in the **Search for company** field. As you type, a list of companies appears in the drop-down.
- 7. Select the company from the drop-down.
- 8. Select the I hereby declare that this information is true and that I am authorised to give this notification to ASIC checkbox.
- 9. Click Lodge form.
