This has been addressed; performance in these areas has been improved significantly.

134080557587 134074855331 134032343371	An error occurred when importing data from an Excel file on the Sales Orders form (SO.30.10.00). This has been resolved.
131652233158 131611118361	On the Sales Orders form (SO.30.10.00), importing sales order lines from a spreadsheet failed with the message "ERROR #111: An error occurred while processing the field INVENTORYID: Specified cast is not valid." This has been resolved.

134455447308 134570291651 134453751148 134772617068	The default endpoints were not available on the Web Service Endpoints form (SM.20.70.60). This has been resolved.
134129863004 134111862110	Customisations did not appear on the Publish Customisation form (SM.20.45.05); existing customisations were still applied to sites, but they could not be modified. This has been resolved.
-	Power BI and OData feeds were not working with recent versions of MYOB Advanced. This has been resolved.
