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Introduction

Welcome to the 2017.1.8 release of MYOB Advanced.

What's New in this Release?

The 2017.1.8 release is focussed on addressing issues identified in previous versions.

Installing this Release

The 2017.1.8 release is automatically deployed to all production accounts.

Note: An updated licence is required to enable configuration options for the new features. While accounts in our managed environment will have their licences updated automatically, a local installation must be updated manually by navigating to the Licence Maintenance (SM.20.15.10) form and clicking the **Update Licence** button.

New Features

Payroll Updates

Employees with the status of "Inactive" or "On Hold" will no longer be included in the following forms:

- Pay Groups (MP.PP.27.10)
- Pay Distribution (MP.PP.23.30)
- Entitlement Adjustments (MP.PP.30.00)
- All pay run forms

Note: Exploration screens will still include employees with any status.

This has been resolved.

143208732423 148153405831 142847071047	In some cases, the Transactions for Period (GL.63.30.00) and Transactions for Account (GL.63.35.00) reports calculated the beginning balance of a General Ledger account incorrectly. This also led to a wrong running total and ending balance of the account. This has been resolved.
144856048562 149666072001 144822646581	Corrected an issue where users occasionally received an error message that a batch was out of balance when releasing payments.
143856778807 142261061011	If on the Reconciliation Statements form (CA.30.20.00) a user reconciled a cash entry, changed the date in the Reconciliation Date box to a date that was earlier than the cash entry date, and then deleted the reconciliation statement, the cash entry remained reconciled even though the reconciliation statement did not exist in the system. This has been resolved.

The new Cost Calculation Basis for Non-Stock Kits box has been added to the Sales Preferences form (SO.10.10.00). This box contains the following options that define the cost calculation rule: • Stock Component Cost: A calculated sum of costs of the stock components updated after release of an inventory issue
	Non-Stock Kit Standard Cost: A standard current cost of a non-stock kit
	 Non-Stock Kit Standard Cost Plus Stock Component Cost: A sum of the stock components of the kit (updated after release of an inventory issue) and the standard current cost of a non-stock kit
144323365194 148329491971 146386695072 145915873971 144199548027 144199548021	A user could not deactivate the default MAIN branch on the Branches form (CS.10.20.00), even if no entities or balances were linked to this branch, because the hidden In-Transit Warehouse entity had always been linked to the branch. This has been resolved.
145466176887 148316537095 147210144781 144492890941 144406572638	When converting an opportunity into a sales order or quote, the GST Taxable Total and Tax Total amounts did not transfer to correctly and were set to zero. This has been resolved.

147933170201 149666071731 147738148651	On the Inventory Transaction History form (IN.40.50.00), some reference links did not open related documents. This has been resolved.
144084486439 143782843411 143710957463	Unreleased invoices printed by using the Print Invoice action on the Process Invoices and Memos form (SO.50.50.00) were displayed in the list of documents available for printing on this form as if they had not been printed before. Additionally, on the form, the invoices that had the Don't Print check box selected were included in the list of the documents to be printed. A similar issue had been experienced with emailing invoices by using the Process Invoices and Memos form. These have been resolved.
147933170201 149666071731 147738148651	Reference Number drill-down links on the Inventory Transaction History form (IN.40.50.00) behaved inconsistently, depending on the transaction type. This has been resolved.
146546138826 146539958911 146855683750 146658865531	Concurrent processes were processing the same oversold transaction simultaneously if the related oversold cost layer had the negative quantity on it. This caused an inability to release IN transactions with the following error: "IN Error: Updating item in warehouse quantity available will go negative." under some circumstances. This has been resolved.
150118431290 150102226631	If a purchase order was created on the Create Purchase Orders form (PO.50.50.00), for the unit cost of this purchase order, the Last Vendor Price or Last Cost value was used instead of the Pending Price value specified on the Vendor Price Worksheets form (AP.20.20.10). This has been resolved.
145309591882 144286465771	If prices for both the Customer and Customer Price Class types were specified with the same quantity in the Break Qty. column for the same item, the Customer check box was cleared and the Customer Price Class check box was selected on the Price/Discount Calculation tab of the Accounts Receivable Preferences form (AR.10.10.00), and the item was applied to a line of a sales order, discount codes were nevertheless applied with the Customer price. This has been resolved.
144868153138 143782842851	The system split multiple landed costs between purchase receipts incorrectly on the Landed Costs tab of the Bills and Adjustments form (AP.30.10.00). This has been resolved.
144361838898 144243899691	The system did not display an error message if a user specified the following incorrect settings for units of measure on the Units Of Measure form (CS.20.31.00); the value of the From Unit column was the same as the value of the To Unit column and the value of the Unit Rate column was not equal to 1. This has been resolved.
147143069286 146978068341	It was possible to delete a sales order line for which a shipment line with zero quantity had been created. As a result, this would prevent posting to inventory. This has been resolved.
145800684771 144527164491	A tax on the freight amount was not calculated when a sales order was created through the Customer Portal. This has been resolved.
146114645077 146076416931	Sometimes a user could not open a sales order that contained a line with UOM, which had been deleted for that inventory item. This has been resolved.

143931975873 143782226501	It was not possible to release an inventory document for an RC order with when-used serial tracked items if the returned serial number had not been issued before. This has been resolved.
146114645077 146076416931	In some cases, the error "unit conversion is missing" appeared when attempting to open a sales order. This has been resolved.
146546138826 146539958911	The error "stock will go into negative" could appear when attempting to release a document on the Release IN Documents form (IN.50.10.00). This has been resolved.
146855683750 146658865531	The error "stock will go into negative" could appear when attempting to process a negative adjustment to write-off a stock item's quantity on the Stock Items form (IN.20.25.00). This has been resolved.
150118431290 150102226631	Replenishment purchase orders used the Last Purchase Order Price instead of the Price List Price in the system, resulting in an incorrect price on the order. This has been resolved.
146849014185	Entities, which were inherited from the default endpoint and not extended within a custom endpoint, were inaccessible via the contract-based REST API. This has been resolved.

146911795504 147555731351 146900669521	The error "Another process has updated the 'SYMapping' record." could appear when trying to link an Import Scenario to a page on a Site Map. This has been resolved.
144444198314 144286575961	In some cases, a user could not paste an inventory ID in the Inventory ID field on the Stock Items (IN.20.25.00) form—this generated the error message "The given key was not present in the dictionary". This has been resolved.

144760326379 144760022056	An API request filtering payments on PaymentRef field took significantly longer than other requests for other fields. This has been resolved.
144807748645 144288970921	If access roles were assigned to branches in the system with multiple branches configured, a user that has access to one specific branch could view data of this branch only but could export the data of all the branches to an Excel file. This has been resolved.

147848783885 147848019716	Entitlements set up in days were not converting between value and days correctly in the valuation. This has been resolved.
-	Unused Annual and Long Service Leave is not liable for super contribution when paid out at termination; however, the default pay items for unused AL and LSL leave had the Liable for Superannuation setting incorrectly ticked. This has been corrected.
	Note: If you have used one of these pay items in an open pay, you should check the liability settings and untick the super, then refresh the item. If you have completed a pay run, you can follow your process for seeking a reversal from the Super Fund. There are limited options for correcting this within the system—if a pay run is complete but the super batch has not been created/saved, you can delete but not modify the employee row.
